

SQL net up 56% at Rs 1.59 cr

■ **HYDERABAD:** Global IT services enterprise SQL Star International has posted a 56% rise in the net profit at Rs 159.80 lakh in the quarter ended December 2007, as against Rs 102.51 lakh for the same quarter in the previous fiscal. "In software services, our Embinux project has delivered significant results in the form of tremendous market acceptance by large corporations in the telecom vertical across the globe. Further, the good monsoons have resulted in higher productivity in the agricultural sector bringing in larger volumes of agricultural produce to the markets; this has increased our revenues from the e-governance vertical," said Mr NR Ganti, chairman and managing director, SQL.

SQL Star International has reported net profit at Rs 1.6 crore in the quarter ended December 31, 2007, up from Rs 1.03 crore for the same quarter of the previous year. Revenue increased 51% at Rs 26.47 crore.
